## Senate Panel Passes Intelligence Bill

The Security Committee of the US Senate on June 26, 2018, ratified a bill that approves financing the national intelligence institutions. The proposed law provides new requirements to restructure the old system of security clearance and deal with aggression from other nations such as China and Russia. The bill will now be presented on the floor of the Senate after it garnered unanimous vote at the committee stage (Riechmann 1).

Moreover, the bill intends to deal with cases of election manipulation. Therefore, it has provided measures to strengthen the security of votes and control antagonists' interference (The Economic Times 1). For this reason, the reforms contained in the proposed legislation will be a key milestone in discouraging insider threats, safeguard confidential data and guarantee the intelligence society has an agile and capable human resource. For instance, the bill seeks to promote modernization of obsolete security clearance procedure and minimize a backlog of security clearance of more than 700,000 individuals (Riechmann 1). Furthermore, it aims to nurture innovation in the intelligence agencies in its operations.
